The meeting was called to order by the Chair, Rep. Linda Miller at 1:00 pm.

Roll was called and all were present, with Rep. Abdul-Samad excused.

The minutes from the previous meeting, February 12, 2015 were approved.

Both parties went to caucus at 1:05 pm.

The committee reconvened at 1:50 pm.

The Chair recognized Rep. Taylor for opening remarks on HSB 81, a study bill relating to the regulation of tanning facilities and making penalties applicable. Rep. Taylor introduced amendment .199 to HSB 81 and it passed by voice vote. The Chair recognized Rep. Rizer to introduce amendment .245 to HSB 81. Following discussion of the amendment a roll call vote was taken. Having received 9 ayes, Rep. Miller, Rep. Best, Rep. Fry, Rep. Gustafson, Rep. Rizer, Rep. Salmon, Rep. Sieck, Rep. Taylor and Rep. Wills, 11 nays, and 1 excused, Rep. Abdul-Samad, amendment .245 did not pass. Following discussion of the bill, Rep. Taylor moved HSB 81 as amended; a roll call vote was taken. Having received 15 ayes, 5 nays, Rep. Fry, Rep. Rizer, Rep. Salmon, Rep. Sieck, Rep. Wills, and 1 excused, Rep. Abdul-Samad, HSB 81 as amended passed as a committee bill.

Seeing no further business to come before the committee, Rep. Sieck moved that the meeting adjourn. The chair adjourned the meeting at 2:00 PM.
