Representative Forristall (CH) called the meeting to order at 2:25 PM.

Roll was taken and a quorum was present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

The committee recessed for party caucuses at 2:30 PM.

Representative Forristall (CH) reconvened the committee at 2:50 PM. The Chair deferred on [HF 116](#).

Representative Forristall (CH) recognized Representative Gassman for opening remarks on [HF 88](#) (an Act defining occasional work for purposes of the state child labor law). After questions and discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Gassman for closing remarks on [HF 88](#).

Representative Gassman moved the bill. The bill passed on a roll call vote of 10 Ayes (Reps. Forristall, Sheets, Fry, Gassman, Hanusa, Holt, Jorgensen, Kooiker, Sexton, & Watts) and 7 Nays (Reps. Hunter, Finkenauer, Kearns, McConkey, Running-Marquardt, Steckman, & T. Taylor). Having received a constitutional majority, [HF 88](#) will move to the House floor as a committee bill.

As there was no other business to come before the committee, Representative Forristall moved for adjournment at 3:05 PM.
