The bill passed with a roll call vote of 23 ayes to 0 nays. Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Representative Stanerson for opening remarks on [HSB 14](#) (An act relating to interstate reciprocity agreements entered into, administered, or recognized by the college student aid commission). After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Stanerson for closing remarks on [HSB 14](#). Representative Stanerson moved [HSB 14](#). The bill passed with a roll call vote of 13 ayes and 10 nays (Abdul-Samad, Brown-Powers, Cohoon, Gaines, Hanson, Mascher, Ruff, Staed, Steckman and Winckler). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.
