The bill passed with a roll call vote of 13 ayes to 10 nays (Abdul-Samad, Brown-Powers, Cohoon, Gaines, Hanson, Mascher, Ruff, Staed, Steckman and Winckler). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Representative Koester for opening remarks on [HSB 199](#) (An act relating to school coaching endorsements and authorizations and certain emergency medical procedures training requirements, and including applicability provisions). After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Koester for closing remarks on [HSB 199](#). Representative Koester moved [HSB 199](#). The bill passed with a roll call vote of 23 ayes to 0 nays. Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Representative Sieck for opening remarks on [HF 462](#) (An act providing for a waiver of eligibility requirements to receive a high school equivalency diploma). After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Sieck for closing remarks on [HF 462](#).

Representative Sieck moved [HF 462](#). The bill passed with a roll call vote of 23 ayes to 0 nays. Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.
