Roll was called and all were present, with Rep. Anderson excused.

Both parties went to caucus at 3:05 PM.

The committee reconvened at 4:30 PM.

The Chair recognized Rep. Fry for opening remarks on <u>HF 58</u>, a bill for an act establishing prerequisites to the performance of an abortion. The Chair recognized Rep. Wessel-Kroeschell to introduce amendment .572, following discussion of the bill there was a roll call vote, having received 9 ayes, Rep. Wessel-Kroeschell, Rep. Abdul-Samad, Rep. Brown-Powers, Rep. Dawson, Rep. Gaines, Rep. Heddens, Rep. McConkey, Rep. Taylor, Rep. Winckler, 11 nays, amendment .572 failed. The Chair recognized Rep. Dawson to introduce amendment .536, following discussion of the bill there was a roll call vote, having received 8 ayes, Rep. Wessel-Kroeschell, Rep. Brown-Powers, Rep. Dawson, Rep. Gaines, Rep. The Chair recognized Rep. Taylor for opening remarks on <u>HSB 101</u>, a study bill relating to the licensure of acupuncturists. Rep. Taylor introduced amendment .677 and it passed by voice vote. Following discussion of the bill, Rep. Taylor moved <u>HSB 101</u> as amended, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 20 ayes, 0 nays, 1 absent, Rep. Anderson <u>HSB 101</u> as amended passed as a committee bill.

Seeing no further business to come before the committee, Rep. Best moved that the meeting adjourn. The chair adjourned the meeting at 4:50 PM.
