Chair Jones turned the committee over to Representative Wills. Chair Wills recognized Representative Jones for opening comments on [HF 162](#). An Act regarding the use of plasma gasification as a waste management practice. The Chair recognized Representative Jones for Amendment 451. The amendment was moved and passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 20 Aye, 0 Nay, and 1 Absent (Heartsill). The bill will move to the house floor as a committee bill as amended.

Chair Jones recognized Representative Wills for opening remarks on on [HSB 208](#). An Act relating to the development of a hub and spoke recycling program and providing for an allocation of moneys from the groundwater protection fund. The Chair recognized Representative Wills for Amendment 681. The amendment was moved and passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote of 19 Aye, 2 Nay (Lensing and Wessel-Kroeschell), and 0 Absent. The bill will move to the house floor as a committee bill as amended.
