[SF 225](#) - A bill for an act establishing employment protections for employees absent from work due to adoptions and making penalties applicable. Amendment 225.467 was adopted by a short form vote of 13 ayes, 2 absent. [SF 225](#) as amended was approved as a committee bill under rule 40 by a roll call vote of 12 ayes, 1 nay (Schultz) AND 2 absent.

[SSB 1213](#) - A study bill for an act relating to the reexamination and recalculation of disability retirement benefits for beneficiaries under the public safety peace officers retirement, accident, and disability system. [SSB 1213](#) was approved as a committee bill by a short form vote of 13 ayes, 2 absent.

[SSB 1073](#) - A study bill for an act relating to governmental bodies and advisory bodies and public notice requirements under the open meetings law and the confidentiality of peace officers investigative reports under the open records law. Amendment 1073.458 was adopted by a short form vote of 13 ayes, 2 absent. [SSB 1073](#) as amended was approved as a committee bill under rule 40 by a short form vote of 13 ayes, 2 absent.

[SSB 1134](#) - A study bill for an act establishing an address confidentiality program in the office of the secretary of state for a victim of domestic abuse, domestic abuse assault, sexual abuse, and stalking or for a person in fear of the persons safety or another persons safety. [SSB 1134](#).210 was adopted by a short form vote of 13 ayes, 2 absent. [SSB 1134](#) as amended was approved as a committee bill under rule 40 by a short form vote of 13 ayes, 2 absent.

[SSB 1172](#) - A study bill for an act relating to licensure of durable medical equipment providers, providing penalties, and including effective date and implementation provisions. [SSB 1172](#).469 was adopted by a short form vote of 13 ayes, 2 absent. [SSB 1172](#) as amended was approved as a committee bill under rule 40 by a short form vote of 13 ayes, 2 absent.
