Following discussion of the bill, Rep. Fry moved SF 463, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 20 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused, Rep. Taylor, SF 463 passed as a committee bill. The Chair recognized Rep. Heaton for opening remarks on SF 464, a bill for an act relating to the prevention of disabilities policy council. Rep. Heddens introduced amendment .1274 and it passed by voice vote. Following discussion of the bill, Rep. Heaton moved SF 464 as amended, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 20 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused, Rep. Taylor, SF 464 passed as a committee bill.
