Chairman Sands recognized Representative Hagenow for opening remarks on [HSB 213](#). An Act concerning the apportionment of certain gross receipts of a broadcaster for purposes of Iowa income tax, and including effective date and applicability provisions.

The chair recognized Representative Hagenow for Amendment 1248. The amendment was moved and passed on short form.

The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 22 Aye, 0 Nay and 3 Absent. The bill will move to the house floor as a Ways & Means committee bill as amended.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Vander Linden for opening remarks on [HSB 218](#). An Act relating to the administration of the streamlined sales and use tax agreement by the department of revenue.

The bill was moved and passed by the vote 22 Aye, 0 Nay and 3 Absent. The bill will move to the house floor as a Ways & Means committee bill.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Baltimore for opening remarks on [HF 340](#). An Act relating to certain fees charged in connection with vehicle rental agreements and making penalties applicable.

The bill was moved and passed by the vote 22 Aye, 0 Nay and 3 Absent. The bill will move to the house floor as a Ways & Means committee bill.
