SF 228 A bill for an act relating to the use of moneys in the anatomical gift public awareness and transplantation fund. Formerly SSB 1118)

HSB 237 A study bill for providing for eligibility and identity verification procedures for certain state programs and services and including implementation provisions.

Chair Soderberg recognized Representative Rizer for opening remarks on SF 402, a bill for an act relating to the state mental health institutes at Clarinda and Mount Pleasant. (Formerly SF 308).

Chair Soderberg recognized Representative Rizer for opening remarks on amendment 402.1311. Discussion from the committee followed. Representative Rizer was recognized for closing comments and the amendment passed, short form. Chair Soderberg redirected the committee back to SF 402, as amended. Discussion followed. The Chair recognized Representative Rizer for closing remarks and Representative Rizer moved the bill as amended. SF 402, as amended, passed 25-0. With passage, SF 402, as amended, moves to the House floor as a Senate bill with a committee amendment.
