Roll Call was read and a quorum was present.

As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the April 8nd meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Cownie for opening remarks on HF 576. An Act relating to and providing for the coordination and facilitation of broadband access in targeted areas of the state, including property tax incentives for broadband infrastructure installation, a broadband grant program and fund, and including applicability provisions.

The chair recognized Representative Cownie for Amendment 1429. The amendment was moved and passed on short form.

The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 24 Aye, 0 Nay and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House floor as a Ways and Means committee bill as amended.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Moore for opening remarks on <u>HF 513</u>. An Act concerning social and charitable gambling and making penalties applicable.

The chair recognized Representative Moore for Amendment 1426. The amendment was moved and passed on short form.

The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 22 Aye, 2 Nay and 1 Absent. The nay votes were Representatives Kelley and Prichard. The bill will move to the House floor as a Ways and Means committee bill as amended.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Vander Linden for opening remarks on <u>HF 487</u>. An Act regulating the sale of portable electronics insurance, including requiring licensure, providing for fees and penalties, and including effective date provisions.

The bill was moved and passed by the vote 24 Aye, 0 Nay and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House floor as a Ways and Means committee bill.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Maxwell for opening remarks on <u>HF 436</u>. An Act concerning the reporting and payment of wine gallonage sales and taxes.

The bill was moved and passed by the vote 24 Aye, 0 Nay and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House floor as a Ways and Means committee bill.
