Chair Soderberg called the Appropriations Committee to order at 1:00 pm. Roll was called; quorum present. Minutes from the April 16, 2015, meeting were approved. Republicans and Democrats went to caucus at 1:05 pm. Chair Soderberg called the meeting back to order at 1:30 pm.

Chair Soderberg recognized Representative Heaton for opening remarks on [HF 198](#) -- A bill for an act relating to Medicaid special needs trusts. Discussion from the committee followed. The Chair recognized Representative Heaton for closing remarks and Representative Heaton moved the bill. [HF 198](#) passed 24-0. Representative Running-Marquardt was excused and did not vote. With passage, [HF 198](#) moves to the House floor as a committee bill.

Chair Soderberg recognized Representative Dolecheck for opening remarks on [HF 554](#) - A bill for an act relating to eligibility to receive funding under the beginning teacher mentoring and induction program. (Formerly [HSB 16](#)). Discussion from the committee followed. The Chair recognized Representative Dolecheck for closing remarks and Representative Dolecheck moved the bill. [HF 554](#) passed 14-10. Representatives voting yes: Soderberg, Rizer, Bacon, Deyoe, Dolecheck, Drake, Fisher, Heaton, Huseman, Landon, Rogers, Sexton, Taylor, R, and Worthan. Representatives voting no: Hall, Bearinger, Dunkel, Forbes, Heddens, Mascher, Oldson, Stutsman, Taylor T, and Thede. Representative Running-Marquardt was excused and did not vote. With passage, [HF 554](#) moves to the House floor as a committee bill.
