Chair Soderberg called the Appropriations Committee to order at 1:00 pm. Roll was called; quorum present. Minutes from the April 21, 2015, meeting were approved. Republicans and Democrats went to caucus at 1:05 pm. Chair Soderberg called the meeting back to order at 1:50 pm.

Chair Soderberg recognized Representative R. Taylor for opening remarks on <u>HF 537</u> – A bill for an act relating to underground storage tanks, by establishing an underground storage tank cost share grant program and fund and making an appropriation. (Formerly <u>HSB 170</u>). The Chair recognized Representative R. Taylor for opening comments on amendment 537.1550. Discussion followed. Representative R. Taylor was recognized for closing comments and the amendment passed, 14-11. Representatives voting yes: Soderberg, Rizer, Bacon, Deyoe, Dolecheck, Drake, Fisher, Heaton, Huseman, Landon, Rogers, Sexton, Taylor, R, and Worthan. Taylor for opening comments 537.1032. Discussion

followed. Representative R. Taylor was recognized for closing comments and the amendment passed, short form.

Chair Soderberg redirected the committee back to <u>HF 537</u>, as amended. Discussion followed. The Chair recognized Representative R. Taylor for closing remarks and Representative R. Taylor moved the bill as amended. <u>HF 537</u>, as amended, passed 25-0. With passage, <u>HF 537</u>, as amended, moves to the House floor as a committee bill.

Chair Soderberg recognized Representative Huseman for opening remarks on <u>HSB 246</u> - A study bill relating to and making appropriations to state departments and agencies from the rebuild Iowa infrastructure fund and the revenue bonds capitals II fund, providing for related matters, and including effective date provisions. Discussion followed. The Chair recognized Representative Huseman for closing remarks and Representative Huseman moved the bill. <u>HSB 246</u> passed 25-0. With passage, <u>HSB 246</u> moves to the House floor as a committee bill. With no further business to come before the committee, Representative Huseman moved to arise at 2:40 pm.
