Chairman Deyoe called the meeting to order at 11:20 AM. Attendance was taken. Quorum was present.

Both parties went to caucus at 11:25. Chairman Deyoe reconvened the meeting at 11:40 AM. Representative Deyoe turned the Chair over to Representative Hanusa. Representative Hanusa recognized Representative Deyoe for opening remarks on [SF 499](#), A bill for an act making appropriations to the department of cultural affairs, the economic development authority, the Iowa finance authority, the public employment relations board, the department of workforce development, and the state board of regents and certain regents institutions, modifying programs and duties of the economic development authority, providing for other properly related matters, and including effective date and retroactive and other applicability provisions. The Chair recognized Representative Deyoe for opening remarks on Amendment 499.1619. Discussion followed. Representative Deyoe was recognized for closing comments and the Amendment passed, 5 - 4. Representatives voting yes: Deyoe, Baxter, Carlson, Hanusa and Sheets. Representatives voting no: Running-Marquardt, Bennett, Finkenauer and Kressig. Chair Hanusa redirected the Committee back to [SF 499](#), as amended. Discussion followed. Chair recognized Representative Deyoe for closing remarks. Representative Deyoe moved the Bill as amended.

Sentate File 499, as amended, passed 5-4. Representatives voting yes: Deyoe, Baxter, Carlson, Hanusa and Sheets. Representatives voting no: Running-Marquardt, Bennett, Finkenauer and Kressig. With passage, [SF 499](#) as amended, moves to the full House Appropriations Committee. The Chair was turned back to Representative Deyoe. With no further business to come before the Committee, Representative Sheets moved to arise at 12:00pm.
