Representative Jorgensen (CH) recognized Representative Moore, T. for opening remarks on HSB 546 (A study bill relating to disciplinary actions taken against a licensed school employee that are required to be reported to the board of educational examiners.) After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Moore, T. for closing remarks on HSB 546. Representative Moore, T. moved HSB 546. The bill passed with a roll call vote of 19 ayes and four absent or not voting (Byrnes, Hanusa, Sieck, and Stanerson). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.

Representative Jorgensen turned the chair over to Representative Gassman.

Representative Gassman (CH) recognized Representative Jorgensen for opening remarks on <u>HF</u> 2101 (A bill for an act concerning varsity athletics eligibility of students in open enrollment subjected to harassment or bullying.) After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Jorgensen for closing remarks on <u>HF 2101</u>. Representative Jorgensen moved <u>HF 2101</u>. The bill passed with a roll call vote of 19 ayes and four absent or not voting (Byrnes, Hanusa, Sieck, and Stanerson). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.

Representative Gassman turned the chair back to Representative Jorgensen. As there was no other business to come before the committee, Representative Abdul-Samad moved to arise.
