Rep. Brown-Powers followed amendment with further discussion. Following discussion, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 19 ayes, 1 nay, 1 excused, [SF 232](#) passed as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Rep. Heaton for opening remarks on [HF 2104](#), a bill for an act relating to subsidized guardianships. Rep. Heaton introduced an amendment to [HF 2104](#) and yielded to questions. Rep. Heaton then moved the amendment be called to a vote, and [HF 2104](#) passed as amended.

Rep. Wessel-Kroeschell followed amendment with further discussion. Following discussion, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 20 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused, [HF 2104](#) passed as a

committee bill.

The Chair recognized Rep. Taylor for opening remarks on [HF 235](#), a bill for an act concerning membership on the commission for the blind. Rep. Taylor introduced an amendment to [HF 235](#) and yielded to questions. Rep. Taylor then moved the amendment be called to a vote, and [HF 235](#) passed as amended.

Rep. McConkey followed amendment with further discussion. Following discussion, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 19 ayes, 1 nay, 1 excused, [HF 235](#) passed as a committee bill.
