Representative Highfill noted there is an amendment.

After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Highfill for closing remarks on amendment [SF 2163](#).2984. Representative Highfill moved the amendment. The amendment was adopted by a voice vote.

The bill passed with a roll call vote of 22 ayes to 0 nays with one absent or not voting (Hanson). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a Senate File.
