Chairman Sands called the meeting to order at 2:30 PM.

Roll Call was read and a quorum was present.

As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the March 2nd meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved.

There were no bills to assign.

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Vander Linden for opening remarks on [HF 2402](#). An Act concerning alcoholic beverage control, including micro-distillery production and sales and dramshop liability insurance requirements, requiring a comprehensive study on alcoholic beverage control, and establishing fees. The chair recognized Representative Vander Linden for Amendment 2402. The amendment was moved and passed on short form.

The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 19 Aye, 4 Nay and 2 Absent. The nay votes were Representatives Brown-Powers, Finkenauer, McConkey and Prichard. The bill will move to the House floor as a Ways and Means Committee bill as amended.
