The Chair, Rep. Bacon, recognized Rep. Miller for opening remarks on <u>SF 2102</u>, a bill for an act relating to access to the information program for drug prescribing and dispensing administered by the board of pharmacy. Rep. Winckler followed opening remarks with further discussion. Following discussion, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 21 ayes, 0 nays, 0 excused, <u>SF 2102</u> passed as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Rep. Miller for opening remarks on SF 2214, a bill relating to the dispensing of additional quantities of a prescription within the limitations of the prescription. Rep. Abdul-Samad followed opening remarks with further discussion. Following discussion, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 21 ayes, 0 nays, 0 excused, SF 2214 passed as a committee bill.

Rep. Bacon returned duties as Chair to Rep. Miller.

The Chair, Rep. Miller, recognized Rep. Fry for opening remarks on <u>SF 2258</u>, a bill for an act concerning child welfare, including provisions relating to children under the custody, control, and supervision of the department of human services and provisions relating to children who are sex trafficking victims. Rep. Fry introduced an amendment and yielded to questions. Following discussion, Rep. Fry moved the amendment be called to a vote, and <u>SF 2258</u> passed as amended.

Rep. Winckler followed amendment with further discussion. Following discussion, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 21 ayes, 0 nays, 0 excused, <u>SF 2258</u> passed as a committee bill.
