Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Highfill for opening comments on SF 166, an act relating to fantasy sports contests. Representative Highfill introduced Amendment 3021 to SF 166. After discussion, Representative Highfill moved Amendment 3021 and it passed by voice vote. Following discussion, Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Highfill for closing comments on SF 166, as amended. Representative Highfill moved SF 166, as amended. A record roll call was taken and SF 166, as amended, passed (15-7) (Nays: Lensing, Hunter, Kelley, Mascher, Prichard, Watts, Winkler) SF 166 moves to the house floor as a committee bill

Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Pettengill for opening comments on <u>SF 2275</u>, an act exempting natural hair braiding from the definition of cosmetology. Representative Pettengill introduced Amendment 2988 to <u>SF 2275</u>. After discussion, Representative Pettengill moved Amendment 2988 and it passed by voice vote. After discussion, Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Pettengill for closing comments on <u>SF 2275</u>, as amended. Representative Pettengill moved <u>SF 2275</u>, as amended. A record roll call was taken and <u>SF 2275</u>, as amended, passed (18-3) (Nays: Lensing, Cohoon, Watts) (R-76: Hein.) <u>SF 2275</u> moves to the house floor as a committee bill.

Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Miller for opening comments on SF 2273, an act relating to licensure of home food establishments by raising the ceiling on gross annual sales for a home food establishment. Representative Miller introduced Amendment 3005 to SF 2273. After discussion, Representative Miller moved Amendment 3005 and it passed by a voice vote. Following discussion, Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Miller for closing comments on SF 2273. Representative Miller moved SF 2273 as amended. A record roll call was taken and SF 2273, as amended, passed (22-0.) SF 2273 moves to the house floor as a committee bill.

Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Moore for opening comments on <u>SF 2162</u>, An act providing for the use of an electronic filing system for administrative proceedings by the administrative hearings division of the department of inspections and appeals. Representative Moore introduced Amendment 2937 to <u>SF 2162</u>. After discussion, Representative Moore moved Amendment 2937 and it passed by voice vote. Following discussion, Chair Vander Linden

recognized Representative Moore for closing comments on SF 2162, as amended. Representative Moore moved SF 2162, as amended. A record roll call was taken and SF 2162, as amended, passed (22-0.) SF 2162 moves to the house floor as a committee bill. Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Stanerson for opening comments on SF 2147, an act including certain board of regents, institutions, peace officers, and civil commitment unit for sex offender's employees in the protection occupation category of the Iowa public employees' retirement system. Following discussion, Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Stanerson for closing comments on SF 2147. Representative Stanerson moved SF 2147. A record roll call was taken and SF 2147 passed (22-0.) SF 2147 moves to the house floor as a committee bill.
