Rep. Dawson followed amendment with further discussion. Following discussion, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 21 ayes, 0 nays, 0 excused, <u>SF 2259</u> passed as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Rep. Forristall for opening remarks on <u>SF 2260</u>, a bill for an act relating to disclosure of ownership and control information for nonprofit corporations under the Medicaid program. Rep. Heddens followed opening remarks with further discussion. Following discussion, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 21 ayes, 0 nays, 0 excused, <u>SF 2260</u> passed as a committee bill.

The Chair recognized Rep. Taylor for opening remarks on <u>SF 2136</u>, a bill for an act requiring immunization against meningococcal disease for certain students. Rep. Brown-Powers, Rep. Rizer and Rep. Gaines followed opening remarks with further discussion. Following discussion, a roll call vote was taken. Having received 18 ayes, 3 nays, 0 excused, <u>SF 2136</u> passed as a

committee bill.
