Chairman Sands recognized Representative Pettengill for opening remarks on <u>HF 530</u>. An Act relating to state mandates on counties, including provisions related to county medical examiner fees and the publication of county resolutions.

The chair recognized Representative Pettengill for Amendment 3192. The amendment was moved and passed on short form.

The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 25 Aye, 0 Nay and 0 Absorption	ent. The bill

Chairman Sands recognized Representative Windschitl for opening remarks on <u>HSB 641</u>. An Act excluding certain promotional play receipts from the definition of adjusted gross receipts for purposes of the wagering tax on gambling games.

The chair recognized Representative Windschitl for Amendment 3131. The amendment was moved and passed on short form.

The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 24 Aye, 1 Nay and 0 Absent. The nay vote was Representative Kelley. The bill will move to the House floor as a Ways and Means Committee bill as amended.
