(Formerly <u>SSB 3074</u>)

The Chair recognized Representative Rogers for opening comments on amendment 2109.3168. Discussion followed. Representative Rogers was recognized for closing comments and the amendment passed, 13-11.

Representative Landon was absent and did not vote. With passage, <u>SF 2109</u>, as amended, moves to the House floor as a committee bill.
