Chair Grassley called the Appropriations Committee to order at 1:00 pm. Roll was called; quorum present. Minutes from the March 21, 2016, meeting were approved.

Republicans and Democrats went to caucus at 1:05 pm. Chair Grassley called the meeting back to order at 1:40 pm.

Chair Grassley recognized Representative Rogers for opening remarks on [SF 2109](#) - A bill for an act relating to financial and regulatory matters by supplementing appropriations for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015, making standing appropriations, and including effective date provisions. (Formerly [SSB 3074](#))

The Chair recognized Representative Rogers for opening comments on amendment 2109.3168. Discussion followed. Representative Rogers was recognized for closing comments and the amendment passed, 13-11.

Representatives voting yes: Grassley, Rizer, Bacon, Deyoe, Dolecheck, Mommsen, Fisher, Heaton, Huseman, Rogers, Sexton, Taylor, R, and Worthan. Representatives voting no: Hall, Bearinger, Dunkel, Forbes, Heddens, Mascher, Oldson, Running-Marquardt, Stutsman, Taylor T, and Thede. Representative Landon was absent and did not vote.

Chair Grassley redirected the committee back to [SF 2109](#), as amended. Discussion followed. The Chair recognized Representative Rogers for closing remarks and Representative Rogers moved the bill as amended. [SF 2109](#), as amended, passed 24-0. Representative Landon was absent and did not vote. With passage, [SF 2109](#), as amended, moves to the House floor as a committee bill.
