**SF 2308** - A bill for an act relating to economic development by establishing an enhance Iowa board to assume the powers and duties of the vision Iowa board and additional powers and duties, establishing an enhance Iowa fund, establishing a sports tourism program and fund, making appropriations, and including transition provisions. (Formerly **SSB 3094** and **SF 2280**).

The Chair recognized Representative Deyoe for closing remarks and Representative Deyoe moved the bill. The bill passed 18-7.
