Chair Grassley called the Appropriations Committee to order at 11:10 am. Roll was called, quorum was present. The Chair assigned the following bills:

Vice-chair Rizer reconvened the committee at 6:55 pm. Both parties went immediately to caucus. Chair Grassley reconvened the meeting at 8:00 pm.

Chair Grassley assigned the following bills:

Chair Grassley recognized Rep. Landon for opening remarks on [SF 2314](#) – Administration and Regulation Appropriations Bill. Discussion followed. The Chair recognized Representative Landon for closing remarks and Representative Landon moved the bill.

[SF 2314](#) passed 14-11. Representatives voting yes: Grassley, Rizer, Bacon, Deyoe, Dolecheck, Fisher, Heaton, Huseman, Landon, Mommsen, Rogers, Sexton, Taylor, R, and Worthan. Representatives voting no: Hall, Bearinger, Dunkel, Forbes, Heddens, Mascher, Oldson, Running-Marquardt, Stutsman, Taylor T, and Thede. With passage, [SF 2314](#) moves to the House floor as a senate file.

Chair Grassley recognized Rep. Rogers for opening remarks on [HF 2381](#)- A bill for an act modifying allocations from the statutory allocations fund, creating the Iowa tanks fund and Iowa tanks fund financing program, repealing a tax credit, making transfers and appropriations, and including transition and effective date provisions. (Formerly [HSB 638](#)) Discussion followed.

The Chair recognized Representative Rogers for opening comments on amendment 3684. Discussion followed. Representative Rogers was recognized for closing comments and the amendment passed, short form.

Chair Grassley redirected the committee back to [HF 2381](#), as amended. Discussion followed. The Chair recognized Representative Rogers for closing remarks and Representative Rogers moved the bill as amended. [HF 2381](#), as amended, passed 25-0. With passage, [HF 2381](#), as amended, moves to the House floor as a committee bill.

With no further business to come before the committee, Representative Heaton moved to arise at 8:10 pm.
