Chair Grassley called the Appropriations Committee to order at 11:05 am. Roll was called; quorum present. Minutes from the April 19, 2016, meeting were approved.

Republicans and Democrats went to caucus at 11:10 pm. Chair Grassley called the meeting back to order at 12:30 pm.

Chair Grassley recognized Representative Bacon for opening comments on <u>SF 492</u> - A bill for an act creating a disaster case management grant fund and program. (Formerly <u>SF 307</u> and <u>SF 411">SF 411.</u>) The Chair recognized Representative Bacon for opening comments on amendment 3413. Discussion followed. Representative Bacon was recognized for closing comments and the amendment passed, short form.

The Chair redirected the committee back to <u>SF 492</u> as amended. Discussion followed. The Chair recognized Representative Bacon for closing remarks and Representative Bacon moved the bill. <u>SF 492</u>, as amended, passed 25-0. With passage, <u>SF 492</u>, as amended moves to the House floor as an amended Senate file.

Chair Grassley recognized Representative Worthan for opening comments on <u>SF 2316</u> - A bill for an act relating to the collection of delinquent court debt and associated installment agreements. (Formerly <u>SSB 3182</u>"><u>SSB 3182</u>.) Discussion followed. The Chair recognized Representative Worthan for closing remarks and Representative Worthan moved the bill. <u>SF 2316</u> passed 25-0. With passage, <u>SF 2316</u> moves to the House floor as a senate file.

Chair Grassley recognized Representative Dolecheck for opening remarks on <u>SF 2323</u> A bill for an act relating to the funding of, the operation of, and appropriation of moneys to the college student aid commission, the department for the blind, the department of education, and the state

board of regents, providing for related matters, and including effective and applicability date provisions. (Formerly <u>SSB 3185</u>"><u>SSB 3185</u>.)

Discussion followed. The Chair recognized Representative Dolecheck for closing remarks and Representative Dolecheck moved the bill. SF 2323 passed 14-11. Representatives voting yes: Grassley, Rizer, Bacon, Deyoe, Dolecheck, Fisher, Heaton, Huseman, Landon, Mommsen, Rogers, Sexton, Taylor, R, and Worthan.

Representatives voting no: Hall, Bearinger, Dunkel, Forbes, Heddens,

Mascher, Oldson, Running-Marquardt, Stutsman, Taylor T, and Thede. With passage, SF 2323 moves to the House floor as a senate file.

Chair Grassley recessed the committee at 1:00 with plans to reconvene after House floor debate and consider SF 2320 at that time.

Chair Grassley reconvened the committee at 7:04 pm.

Chair Grassley recognized Representative Huseman for opening remarks on SF 2320 – A bill for an act relating to transportation and other infrastructure-related appropriations to the department of transportation, including allocation and use of moneys from the road use tax fund, the primary road fund, the state aviation fund, and the federal surface transportation block grant program.

The Chair recognized Representative Huseman for opening comments on amendment

3701. Discussion followed. Representative Huseman was recognized for closing

comments and the amendment passed 14-11. Representatives voting yes: Grassley, Rizer, Bacon, Deyoe, Dolecheck, Fisher, Heaton, Huseman, Landon, Mommsen, Rogers, Sexton, Taylor, R, and Worthan.

Representatives voting no: Hall, Bearinger, Dunkel, Forbes, Heddens, Mascher, Oldson, Running-Marquardt, Stutsman, Taylor T, and Thede.

Chair Grassley redirected the committee back to SF 2320, as amended. Discussion followed. The Chair recognized Representative Huseman for closing remarks and Representative Huseman moved the bill as amended. SF 2320, as amended, passed 14-11.
