Chairman Sands recognized Representative Windschitl for opening remarks on <u>HSB 658</u>. An Act relating to the administration of the tax and related laws by the department of revenue, including the renewable energy tax credit, appeal procedures for certain centrally assessed property, an extension of the utility replacement tax task force, a sales and use tax exemption for certain items used in performance of a construction contract with designated exempt entities, and including effective date and retroactive and other applicability provisions. The Chair recognized Representative Windschill for Amendment 3876. The amendment was moved and passed on short form.

The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 24 Aye, 0 Nay and 1 Absent. <u>HSB 658</u> as amended will move to the House floor as a Ways and Means Committee bill.
