Representative Carlson (CH) called the committee to order at 1:05 pm.

The Roll was taken.

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved.

The committee reconvened at 1:13 pm.

Representative Carlson (CH) recognized Representative Hager for opening remarks on [HSB 66](#) (A bill for an act permitting motor vehicles to stand unattended without first stopping the engine.) After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Hager for closing remarks on [HSB 66](#). Representative Hager moved [HSB 66](#). The bill passed with a roll call vote of 18 ayes to 0 with three absent or not voting (Huseman, Seick, and Worthan). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.

Representative Carlson (CH) recognized Representative Hinson for opening remarks on [HSB 70](#) (A bill for an act requiring the removal of motor vehicles involved in certain accidents from the roadway, and providing a penalty.) After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Hinson for closing remarks on [HSB 70](#). Representative Hinson moved [HSB 70](#). The bill passed with a roll call vote of 20 ayes to 0 with one absent or not voting (Huseman). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.

As there was no other business to come before the committee, Representative Forbes moved to arise.

The committee adjourned at 1:20 pm.
