Minutes from 2/27/17 and 2/28/17 were unanimously approved.

Chairman Smith recognized Senator Chapman, subcommittee chair for [SSB 1135](#), to give opening remarks. Discussion on the bill was had. Closing remarks were made by Senator Chapman. A short form vote was requested and held. [SSB 1135](#) passed by a vote of 11 AYES, 3 NAYS (Bisignano, Jochum and Petersen) and 1 absent (Anderson).

[SSB 1135](#) moves to the calendar as a committee bill.

Chairman Smith recognized Senator Schneider, subcommittee chair for [SSB 1082](#), to give opening remarks. Senator Schneider made opening remarks on amendment [SSB 1082.778](#). No discussion was had on the amendment. Senator Schneider made closing remarks on the amendment and moved for a vote. Short form vote was requested. A short form vote was taken. [SSB 1082.778](#) passed with 14 Senators voting Aye, 0 Senators voting Nay and 1 Senator absent (Anderson). Discussion was had on the bill. Senator Schneider gave closing remarks and moved the bill to a vote. A short form vote was requested. [SSB 1082](#) passed by a vote of 10 AYES, 4 NAYS (Bisignano, Danielson, Jochum and Peterson) and 1 absent (Anderson). [SSB 1082](#), as amended, moves to the calendar as a committee bill under Rule 40.

Chairman Smith recognized Senator Schneider, subcommittee chair for [SSB 1109](#), to give opening remarks. Senator Schneider gave opening remarks on [SSB 1109.964](#). No discussion was held on the amendment. Senator Schneider gave closing remarks. A short form vote was requested. [SSB 1109.964](#) passed with 14 AYES, 0 NAYS and 1 absent (Anderson). Discussion was had on the bill. Unanimous consent was requested and granted to ask Megan Tooker from Iowa Ethics & Disclosure Board to answer questions. Senator Schneider requested the bill to be deferred. Unanimous consent was granted to defer the bill.
