The subcommittee report of Reps. Vander Linden, Cownie, and Oldson was submitted. Rep. Vander Linden gave opening remarks followed by discussion, and with closing remarks Rep. Vander Linden moved the bill. Chair Cownie moved SF 230, on a roll call vote. The bill will move to the House floor, as a Senate File. Motion carried with 21 ayes.

<u>SF 1</u> – Representative Pettengill was recognized to take up <u>SF 1</u>; A bill for an act requiring jobs impact statements for administrative rules. The subcommittee report of Reps. Pettengill, Vander Linden, and Finkenauer was submitted. Rep. Pettengill gave opening remarks followed by discussion, and with closing remarks Rep. Pettengill moved the bill. Chair Cownie moved <u>SF 1</u>, on a roll call vote. The bill will move to the House floor, as a Senate File. Motion carried with 21 ayes.
