[HF 564](#) passed unanimously on a voice vote.

Senator Quirnbach requested the committee look at information passed out before the committee that addressed some of his concerns with the bill.

Senator Lofgren gave his closing comments and expressed his willingness to work with Senator Quirnbach on the bill.

[HF 573](#) passed on a 12-2 on a roll call vote with Senators Quirnbach and Dvorsky voting no.
