After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Worthan for closing remarks on [SF 234](#). Representative Worthan moved [SF 234](#). The bill passed with a roll call vote of 21 ayes to 0 nays. Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.

Representative Carlson (CH) recognized Representative Best for opening remarks on [SF 406](#) (A bill for an act exempting motor vehicles carrying an implement of husbandry from certain permit requirements.) After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Best for closing remarks on [SF 406](#). Representative Best moved [SF 406](#). The bill passed with a roll call vote of 21 ayes to 0 nays. Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.
