Roll call was called with a quorum present.

Chairman Cownie asked for any revisions to the minutes of March 28th meeting. Hearing none, the minutes were unanimously approved.

Chairman Cownie gave opening remarks and turned the chair over to Representative Mohr and Representative Cownie was recognized to take up <u>SF 51</u>; A bill for an act relating to a cytomegalovirus public health initiative and the testing of newborns for congenital cytomegalovirus. The subcommittee report of Reps. Cownie, Best and Forbes was submitted and signed. Rep. Cownie gave opening remarks, followed by discussion. Rep. Cownie gave closing remarks and moved the bill. Chair Mohr moved <u>SF 51</u>, to the House floor, as a Senate File on a roll call vote. Motion carried with 22 ayes, 0 nay, 1 absent (Rep. Jacoby).

Chairman Mohr turned the chair back to Representative Cownie.

Representative Vander Linden was recognized to take up <u>SF 431</u>; A bill for an act relating to the siting of small wireless facilities. The subcommittee report of Reps. Vander Linden, Mohr and Hall was submitted and signed. Rep. Vander Linden gave opening remarks. Discussion followed. Rep. Vander Linden gave closing remarks and moved the bill. Chair Cownie moved <u>SF 431</u>, to the House floor as a Senate File on a roll call vote. Motion carried with 20 ayes, 2 nay, (Rep. Landon and Rep. Pettengill), 1 absent (Rep. Jacoby).

With no further business to come before the Committee, Chairman Cownie gave closing remarks and moved to adjourn and Representative Mohr seconded the motion.
