Chairman Fry called the meeting to order at 3:00 pm.

Roll Call was read and a quorum was present.

As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the March 28, 2017 meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved.

The meeting stood at ease for both parties to caucus at 3:05 pm.

The meeting reconvened at 7:10 pm.

Chairman Fry recognized Representative Lundgren for opening remarks on [SF 471](#): A bill for an act relating to feticide, making penalties applicable, and including effective date provisions.

The Chair recognized Representative Lundgren for opening remarks on Amendment 471.1863. The amendment was moved and passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed by the vote 11 Aye, 8 Nay, and 2 Absent. The bill will move to the House floor as a Senate File as amended.

Chairman Fry recognized Representative Bacon for opening remarks on [SF 484](#): A bill for an act relating to pharmacy regulation, including alternate board of pharmacy members, drug disposal program funding, an impaired professionals program, and pharmacy internet sites.

The bill moved and passed with the vote of 19 Aye, 0 Nay, and 2 Absent. The bill will move to the House floor as a Senate File.

As there was no additional business to come before the committee, Representative Mascher moved to adjourn at 9:20 pm.
