After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Sieck for closing remarks on <u>SF 449</u> . Representative Sieck moved <u>SF 449</u> . The bill passed with a roll call vote of 18 ayes to 2 nays (Jacoby and Wills) with one absent or not voting (Landon). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.		
Representative Carlson (CH) recognized Representative Mohr for opening remarks on SF 220 (A bill for an act regulating the use of automated traffic law enforcement systems, and providing a penalty.) After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Mohr for closing remarks on SF 220. Representative Mohr moved SF 220. The bill passed with a roll call vote of 13 ayes to 8 nays (Forbes, Cohoon, Finkenauer, Heddens, Jacoby, Olson, Ourth, Smith, R.) Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.
