Representative Nunn introduced Amendment 2275 to <u>HSB 197</u>. After discussion, Representative Nunn moved Amendment 2275 and it passed by voice vote. Following discussion, Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Nunn for closing comments on <u>HSB 197</u>, as amended. Representative Nunn moved <u>HSB 197</u>, as amended. A record roll call was taken and <u>HSB 197</u>,

as amended, passed (18-4) (Nays: Isenhart, Kearns, Kurth, Prichard). <u>HSB 197</u> moves to the house floor as a committee bill.

Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Rizer for opening comments on <u>HSB 194</u>, a bill for an act relating to county funding of mental health and disability services by modifying the mental health and disability services property tax levy and certain county hospital property tax levies, requiring the use of specified reserve funds, and including effective date and applicability provisions. Representative Rizer introduced Amendment 2283 to <u>HSB 194</u>. After discussion, Representative Rizer moved Amendment 2283 and it passed by voice vote. Following discussion, Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Rizer for closing comments on <u>HSB 194</u>, as amended. Representative Rizer moved <u>HSB 194</u>, as amended. A record roll call was taken and <u>HSB 194</u>, as amended, passed (22-0) (Nays: None). <u>HSB 194</u> moves to the house floor as a committee bill.
