Chair Vander Linden called the meeting to order at 12:29 pm. Both parties went to caucus. The meeting reconvened at 12:42 pm.

Roll call was taken; a quorum was present. The minutes from the last meeting were approved. Chair Vander Linden requested unanimous consent to move into a Subcommittee as a Whole for consideration of [SF 488](#). Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Mohr for opening comments on [SF 488](#), an act relating to the workforce housing tax incentives program by requiring allocations to certain housing projects and by increasing the allowable average dwelling unit cost and the percentage of investment for tax incentives for certain housing projects. Discussion followed. Representative Mohr moved the bill and it was passed on short form. The Sub Committee of the Whole dissolved back into the Committee. The Committee reconvened. Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Mohr for opening remarks on [SF 488](#). Discussion followed. The bill was moved and it passed by the vote 23 Aye, 0 Nay and 2 Excused (Baltimore, Prichard).

Chair Vander Linden recognized Representative Holt for opening comments on [SF 501](#), an act relating to certain fees collected by the county sheriff. Discussion followed. The bill was moved and it passed by the vote 23 Aye, 0 Nay and 2 Excused (Baltimore, Prichard).
