The meeting came to order at 2:02 pm.

Roll call silently.

Minutes were approved.

Subcommittee assignments were distributed.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair removed [SF 128](#) and [SSB 3002](#) from the agenda.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair brought up [SF 2004](#).

Senator C. Johnson gave the subcommittee report.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator C. Johnson for an amendment.

Senator C. Johnson introduced senate amendment 2004.2748.

Senator Bowman asked Senator C. Johnson to yield.

Senator C. Johnson complied.

Senator Bowman asked for clarification on the amendment

Senator Sinclair and Senator Johnson gave further clarification on the amendment.

Senate amendment 2004.2748 passed unanimously through a short form vote.

Senator C. Johnson moved to pass [SF 2004](#) with amendment.

[SF 2004](#) as amended passed unanimously through short form vote.

[Sf 2004](#) moved to the calendar waiving rule 40.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair brought up [SSB 3029](#).

Senator Lofgren was recognized and introduced [SSB 3029](#). The subcommittee report was delivered.

Senator Lofgren introduced senate amendment 3029.2755.

Senate amendment 3029.2755 passed unanimously through a short form vote.

Senator Chelgren asked a clarification question over [SSB 3029](#).

Senator Lofgren moved [SSB 3029](#).

[SSB 3029](#) passed unanimously through a short form vote.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair introduced Deborah Reed to give a presentation regarding the Iowa Reading Research Center.

Dr. Reed presented to the committee regarding the amount of employees the center has, the areas the center covers, and what different services are offered. One of which includes Dyslexia training. Dr. Reed showed the committee which schools had utilized the training and clarified when different schools were choosing to have the training. Dr. Reed went on to describe what the needs of the community are and how the Center is trying to help meet these needs. Dr. Reed described the different partnerships that help address different needs. Dr. Reed described one of the major projects of the center, the Early Literacy Blueprint, and shared the Centers progress with the committee.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair thanked Dr. Reed for the presentation.

Senator Quirnbach asked Dr. Reed about past research regarding the summer reading program.

Dr. Reed gave an update to the committee regarding the summer reading program and showed a diagram highlighting the improvements of student literacy and the programs overall effectiveness.

Senator Quirnbach thanked Dr. Reed and encouraged her to continue her work.

Senator Chelgren asked if the videos used to help train teachers were available online for private schools.

Dr. Reed explained that they were not available online yet due to legal complications regarding children being in the videos and clarified for Senator Sinclair that all the videos were shared with the AEA.

Senator Kraayenbrink asked Dr. Reed if colleges were willing to use the tools the Center had developed in teacher education programs.

Dr. Reed confirmed that there was interest among teach preparation programs for the blueprint, Dr. Reed explained that an advisory committee was formed in December for the Center who are looking into more ways to get the instruction out.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair thanked Dr. Reed once again for coming and presenting to the committee.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair introduced the next group of presenters from Decoding Dyslexia.

Members from Decoding Dyslexia thanked the committee for their time and began introducing themselves to the committee.

The group began by explaining what dyslexia was and gave some statistics to show how common dyslexia was. They described what the group does in regards to helping Iowa families, raising awareness, and educating others. The group asked the committee to form a task force to help make systematic changes that the organization does not have the resources to make on its own.

They then shared stories about what families face who have troubling finding answers and resources from family members with dyslexia.

Senator Chelgren thanked the group for coming and asked that the group consider putting a focus on helping students in the math and science areas as well.

Senator Quirnbach thanked the group for their work on this issue and encouraged Decoding Dyslexia to work with the Iowa Reading Research Center.

Senator Behn asked for clarification regarding direct systematic learning for students.

The group clarified what the predominate approach to teaching students how to read was and why direct systematic learning is better.

Senator Rozenboom expressed his shock that nothing was being done in schools currently.

Senator Hart expressed her concerns regarding how the teachers themselves weren't being equipped with the skills to recognize and help students with dyslexia. Senator Hart went on to show how this is only one example of how teachers are being overstretched beyond what their training has provided.

Senator Sinclair thanked the group for coming and their work to help students.

Senator Danielson moved to adjourn.
