Meeting came to order at 4:06pm.

The previous minutes were approved.

The subcommittee assignments were distributed.

Democrats caucused briefly.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair called up SF 128.

Senator Chelgren introduced <u>SF 128</u> and gave the subcommittee report and opening remarks. Senator Quirmbach commented briefly on the bill and an issue he hoped to see addressed in future legislation that was not addressed in <u>SF 128</u>.

Senator Chelgren gave closing comments on Senate Amendment 128.2831 and moved the amendment.

The amendment passed unanimously on a short form vote.

Seeing no further discussion on <u>SF 128</u> Senator Chelgren moved the bill.

SF 128 passed 13-2 through a short form vote with Senator's Hogg and Dvorsky voting no. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair introduced the presenters from the Iowa's Area Education Agencies.

The group gave a detailed update over Iowa's AEA's. They discussed the AEA's budget, who the AEA serve, and some of the services the AEA provides. The group discussed the work they are doing with special education.

Next the group discussed a new system called AEA Scout which will allow for teachers to use the digital resources more efficiently and effectively. The system aims to make the digital instructional resources more accessible and allow the AEA to receive feedback over what is being utilized. The system will be piloted in the spring of 2018 and launched fall of 2018. Finally the group discussed the Postsecondary Readiness & Preparation program that will help prepare high school students for higher education.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair thanked the AEA representatives for coming and sharing the updates with the committee.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Chelgren.

Senator Chelgren thanked the department for the updates have made and asked for calcification why there are nine AEA's in Iowa.

The group clarified that they originally started with fifteen AEA's and in the past decade have downsized to nine and have focused primarily on the improvements that have been made. They agreed that it may be time to look further into consolidating and looking into the question of whether or not an AEA is to big or to small, they also clarified that the smaller the AEA gets, the less personable the work gets.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Bowman.

Senator Bowman asked how staff assignments were determined in regards to special education training and asked about the cost of building the scout system.

The group discussed how each relationship with each district is different and the process is determined upon those relationships. They also confirmed there was a one time cost for creating the system and discussed how the majority of the funding went into the data and resources available in the system.

Senator Sinclair asked for some examples of the AEA's physical resources.

The group discussed the manipulatives available for students, the adaptive technologies and toys for special education students, and the rotation of books between districts.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Vice Chair Senator Edler.

Vice Chair Senator Edler asked about efficiency of the AEA.

The group gave further clarification and examples.

The group thanked the committee for the opportunity and welcomed the committee to reach out with any further questions.

Senator Rozenboom moved to adjourn.

The committee adjourned at 5:01 pm.
