After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative G. Mohr for closing remarks on [HSB 534](#). Representative G. Mohr moved [HSB 534](#). The bill passed with a roll call vote of 20 ayes to 0 nays with 1 absent or not voting (Heddens). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.

Representative Carlson (CH) recognized Representative Hinson for opening remarks on [HSB 536](#) (A bill for an act relating to the administration of driving skills tests required for a commercial driver's license.) After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Hinson for closing remarks on [HSB 536](#). Representative Hinson moved [HSB 536](#).
