The chair recognized Representative Dolecheck for Amendment 2919. After discussion and closing comments, Representative Dolecheck moved Amendment 2919. Amendment 2919 passed by the vote 14 Aye, 8 Nay, and 1 Absent. The Nay votes were: Representatives Steckman, Breckenridge, Brown-Powers, Gaines, Mascher, P. Miller, Nielsen and Staed.

The chair recognized Representative Dolecheck for further discussion and comments on [HSB 586](#) as amended. Representative Dolecheck moved [HSB 586](#) as amended and passed on the vote 14 Aye, 8 Nay, and 1 Absent. The Nay votes were: Representatives Steckman, Breckenridge, Brown-Powers, Gaines, Mascher, P. Miller, Nielsen and Staed. [HSB 586](#) passed as amended as a Committee Bill.

The chair recognized Representative Salmon for opening comments on [HSB 578](#). (*A bill for an act relating to statewide assessments of student progress for purposes of core academic indicators, and including effective date provisions.*)

After discussion and closing comments, Representative Salmon moved [HSB 578](#). [HSB 578](#) passed by the vote 21 Ayes, 1 Nay, and 1 Absent. The Nay vote was Representative Staed. [HSB 578](#) passed as a Committee Bill.

With no further business to come before the committee, Representative Nielsen moved to arise.
