Representative Dan Huseman, Co-chairman, called the meeting to order at 10:15 a.m. The roll call was dispensed with and a quorum declared present.

Minutes of the January 31 meeting were approved as presented.

Presentations were provided by the following:

Chris Kramer, Acting Director, Iowa Department of Cultural of Cultural Affairs; Susan Kloewer, Administrator, State historical Society of Iowa, a division of the Department of Cultural Affairs; Channing Swanson, Principal, Neumann Monson Architects, and Craig A. Thompson, Division Manager, Ryan Companies US, Inc.

Ms. Kramer explained the need of the State Historical Building and how those needs have been prioritized. Priority 1 for FY 2018 is give immediate attention to roof area building envelope issues. Priority 2 for FY 2019 is to replace roof, replace skylights, apply vapor barrier. Priority 3 for FY 2020 is focus on Exterior Vapor Barrier Issues. Priority 4 for FY 2021 is replacing HVAC and building MEP system upgrade. Priority 5 is Future years Interior Updates and Improvements and Priority 6 would be Exterior Grounds. The Governor's total recommendations for these projects are \$46.2 million.

Ms Kloewer shared information regarding the goals of the State Historical Society of Iowa. Channing Swanson and Craig Thompson reviewed the goals to the improvement and updating of the State Historical Building. Committee members asked questions about the project and were interested in the presentation and goals.
