Meeting came to order at 3:08 pm.

Roll call was done silently by the committee secretary.

The subcommittee assignments were distributed.

Republicans and Democrats briefly caucused.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair turned the chair over to Vice Chair Senator Edler.

Vice Chair Senator Edler recognized Senator Sinclair for [SSB 3109](#).

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair introduced [SSB 3109](#), gave the subcommittee report, and gave opening comments on the bill.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair introduced Senate Amendment 3109.2940.

Vice Chair Senator Edler recognized Ranking Member Senator Quirmbach.

Ranking Member Senator Quirmbach gave comments over the amendment regarding his disappointment and explained the information distributed to the committee regarding allowable growth and inflation.

Vice Chair Senator Edler recognized Senator Bowman.

Senator Bowman commented on the amendment noting his appreciation of trying to move the bill today but expressed his dismay over having certain information available an hour before the committee.

Vice Chair Senator Edler recognized Senator Chelgren.

Senator Chelgren thanked Senator Bowman for his comments and the committee for taking up this bill today so he can have the weekend to look over the bill and discussed with his constituents. He also commented briefly on Ranking Member Senator Quirmbach's information

distributed.

Vice Chair Senator Edler recognized Senator Hart

Senator Hart asked Senator Sinclair questions regarding how many districts would be on budget guarantee. Chairwoman Senator Sinclair answered Senator Hart's question and clarified as soon as she had more information she would pass it along.

Vice Chair Senator Edler recognized Senator Rozenboom.

Senator Rozenboom asked for the minority party's help in finding extra money and where they would recommend taking money from.

Vice Chair Senator Edler recognized Senator Kraayenbrink.

Senator Kraayenbrink gave comments regarding conversations he has had with superintendents and shared their understanding over the budget situation and their appreciation for being left out of the deappropriation process.

Vice Chair Senator Edler recognized Ranking Member Senator Quirnbach.

Ranking Member Senator Quirnbach expressed his agreement with Senator Bowman and Senator Hart's comments and commented on Senator Chelgren's comments.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair gave closing comments that responded to many of the senator's questions and comments previously made and moved the amendment.

Senate Amendment 3109.2940 passed through a record roll call vote 9-6 with Senators Sinclair, Edler, Behn, Chelgren, Greene, C. Johnson, Kraayenbrink, Lofgren, and Rozenboom voting yes and Senators Quirnbach, Bowman, Danielson, Dvorsky, Hart, and Hogg voting no.

Vice Chair Senator Edler asked if there was any further discussion on [SSB 3109](#) and recognized Ranking Member Senator Quirnbach.

Ranking Member Senator Quirnbach commented on Chairwoman Senator Sinclair's closing comments made during discussion over the amendment.

Vice Chair Senator Edler recognized Senator Bowman.

Senator Bowman clarified what the SSA dollars do in the education system and clarified some of Senator Quirnbach's comments.

Vice Chair Senator Edler recognized Senator Chelgren.

Senator Chelgren gave comments thanking Senator Bowman and asking for future information distributed to the committee to be clearer.

Senator Sinclair gave closing comments and moved [SSB 3109](#).

[SSB 3109](#) passed through a roll call vote 9-6 as a committee bill under rule 40 with Senators Sinclair, Edler, Behn, Chelgren, Greene, C. Johnson, Kraayenbrink, Lofgren, and Rozenboom voting yes and Senators Quirnbach, Bowman, Danielson, Dvorsky, Hart, and Hogg voting no.

Senator Dvorsky moved to adjourn.

The committee adjourned at 3:58 pm.
