Senator Kinney requested a short form vote. Ayes All. Motion carried.

Senator Brown stated [SSB 3145](#), as amended, moves to the calendar as a committee bill under Rule 40 and turned the chair back over to Senator Zumbach.

Discussion ensued regarding a necessary title change amendment which will be addressed when the bill comes to the floor.
