The committee reconvened at 10:37 am.

Representative Carlson (CH) recognized Representative Sieck for opening remarks on [SF 449](#) (A bill for an act relating to the installation of cattle guards by landowners along certain streets or highways, and including effective date provisions.) Representative Sieck noted there was an amendment.

The Chair recognized Representative Sieck for opening remarks on amendment [SF 449.3293](#). After discussion, the Chair recognized Representative Sieck for closing remarks on amendment [SF 449.3293](#). Representative Sieck moved the amendment. The amendment was adopted by a voice vote.

The bill passed with a roll call vote of 18 ayes to 2 nays (Jacoby, Wills) with 1 absent or not voting (Hager). Having received a constitutional majority, the bill will move to the floor as a committee bill.
