Chairman Rogers called the meeting to order at 3:00 P.M.

Roll Call was read and a quorum was present.

The minutes were approved from the previous meeting.

The following bills were assigned:

HSB 670 - Mommsen – Chair, T. Moore & Steckman

The meeting stood at ease for both parties to caucus at 3:05 P.M. The meeting reconvened at 4:45 P.M.

Chairman Rogers recognized Representative Jones for opening comments on HF 2006. (A bill for an act providing for brain injury policies for certain extracurricular interscholastic activities, and including applicability provisions.)

The chair recognized Representative Jones for opening comments on Amendment 3206. After discussion and closing comments on Amendment 3206, Representative Jones moved Amendment 3206 and was passed on short form.

After further discussion and closing comments on <u>HF 2006</u> as amended, Representative Jones moved the bill. <u>HF 2006</u> as amended passed on the vote 21 Aye, 2 Nay, and 0 Absent. The Nay votes were: Representative T. Moore and Wheeler. <u>HF 2006</u> as amended will move to the House Floor as an Education Committee bill.

The chair recognized Representative Jacobsen for opening comments on HSB 663. (A bill for an act relating to the components of a comparable system of career paths and compensation for school districts.)

The chair recognized Representative Bossman for opening comments on Amendment 3384. After discussion and closing comments on Amendment 3384, Representative Bossman moved Amendment 3384 and was passed on short form.

After further discussion the chair recognized Representative Jacobsen for closing comments on HSB 663 as amended. Representative Jacobsen moved the bill as amended. HSB 663 as amended passed on the vote 20 Aye, 3 Nay, and 0 Absent. They Nay votes were: Representatives Gassman, Salmon, and Wheeler. HSB 663 as amended will move to the House Floor as an Education Committee bill.

The chair recognized Representative Koester for opening comments on HSB 660. (A bill for an act relating to school meal debt and to school meal programs offered by school districts and accredited nonpublic schools, authorizing the establishment of unpaid student meals accounts, and authorizing the transfer and expenditure of certain funds.)

The chair recognized Representative Koester for opening comments on Amendment 3408. After discussion and closing comments on Amendment 3408, it was passed on short form.

After discussion and further comments on <u>HSB 660</u> as amended, Representative Koester moved <u>HSB 660</u> as amended. The bill as amended passed on the vote 23 Aye, 0 Nay, and 0 Absent. <u>HSB 660</u> as amended will move to the House Floor as an Education Committee bill.

With no further business to come before the committee, Representative Salmon moved to arise.
