The bill moved and passed with a vote of 19 Aye, 0 Nay, and 2 Absent. The bill will move to the House floor as a Senate File.

Chairman Fry recognized Representative Bergan for opening remarks on SF 2334: A bill for an

Act relating to the regulation of hospitals, including the issuance of licenses and the conversion of hospitals.
The bill moved and passed with a vote of 19 Aye, 0 Nay, and 2 Absent. The bill will move to the House floor as a Senate File.
