The meeting came to order at 1:02 pm.

Roll call was taken silently by the clerk.

Subcommittee assignments were distributed.

Minutes were approved.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair removed [HF 2235](#) from today's agenda.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair introduced Colonel Tim Glynn and Lt. Colonel Jason Wisehart for a presentation from the National Guard.

Colonel Glynn introduced himself and Lt. Colonel Wisehart and gave a brief overview of what they would be presenting today.

Lt. Colonel Wisehart discussed the ASVAB career exploration program and the National Guards initiative to meet "Future Ready Iowa" titled Enlist/Educate/Employ (E3). Currently the ASVAB is not on the CIS list of potential tests that superintendents can pick from. The National Guard is working with the Department of Education and is working toward having the ASVAB added to the CIS list.

Colonel Glynn discussed the STEM/CTE efforts that are aimed toward helping high school students explore what is out there and what they may be interested in. He went on to share some of the resources available at Camp Dodge to help training. Some examples included 3D printers and flight stimulators.

Colonel Glynn next shared what the Home Base Iowa program was doing in the upcoming years. Home Base Iowa is a program helping to serve veterans coming off active duty and in the state enter civilian life. Home Base Iowa supports "Future Ready Iowa" and works towards providing a trained workforce.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair thanked the presenters for their service and coming to present.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair recognized Senator Bowman.

Senator Bowman asked if the National Guard was collaborating with the other branches of military, where the test was distributed, and recruitment numbers.

Lt. Colonel Wisehart confirmed that there is some competition in recruiting and all programs are different, but confirmed that the ASVAB was a collaboration with all the branches of the military because the test focused on finding what was best for the student. He then clarified that there were a few different options for administering the tests either in the school or at other venues.

Colonel Glynn confirmed that the Iowa National Guard down 1% from where they would want to be and loses around 800 members per year but working to improve that and is doing quite well compared to other states.

Chairwoman Senator Greene expressed his appreciation for their service.

Senator Hogg asked for the Colonel to elaborate on any recruitment barriers they may be experiencing and what help the Legislator could provide.

Colonel Glynn shared that there seems to be a bell shape curve regarding recruitment and how a majority of recruits were from military families.

Lt. Colonel Wisehart shared how many potential recruits are unable to join due to failing the ASVAB or medical issues that disqualify potential recruits.

Chairwoman Senator Sinclair thanked the members for presenting.

Senator Greene moved to arise.

The committee adjourned at 1:35 pm.
