

M I N U T E S
LEGISLATIVE FISCAL SUBCOMMITTEE
OF THE
LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

The Legislative Fiscal subcommittee of the Legislative Council met in the office of the Legislative Fiscal Director at 2:15 P.M., July 10, 1973. Present were:

Topics discussed were (1) visitations, (2) uniform reporting of departmental budgets, (3) staffing of subcommittees, (4) budget of the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, and (5) qualifications of Budget Analyst IV to staff education committee.

The Legislative Fiscal Director reported on the activities of the Legislative Fiscal Bureau since the end of the session. He stated that a summary of appropriations will be mailed with the quarterly report to all legislators about the 15th of July.

The Fiscal Director also informed the committee that at the direction of Representative Lipsky he had invited Mortimer Dittenhofer of the General Accounting Office in Washington to meet with the committee regarding performance auditing. Mr. Dittenhofer has indicated he could come to Des Moines for this purpose on August 6.

A meeting of the Legislative Fiscal Committee was scheduled for 10:00 A.M., July 24, 1973 to be held in the conference room of the Legislative Fiscal Bureau. At the request of the subcommittee, Marvin R. Selden, Jr., State Comptroller, will be invited to appear before the committee on that date to report on activities of the Comptroller's Office. The appropriations subcommittee chairmen of the House and Senate will be invited to attend the afternoon session beginning at 1:00 P.M. on July 24, 1973 to express their views to the committee on fiscal matters that need to be reviewed during this interim. Approximately 15 minutes will be allotted to each subcommittee for their presentation. All suggestions shall be presented by the subcommittee chairmen to the Legislative Fiscal Committee in writing.
